

The laws of World Bowls and World Indoor Bowls Council shall apply with the following amendments and additions:

Amendments (delete existing law or paragraph, replace with following):

- IA Controlling Body means the body having immediate control of the conditions under which a competition or event is played. In all IPC sanctioned events this shall be IPC Bowls.
- 9B Bias of bowls – Outdoor and Indoor versions
Composition bowls must bear a legible registered stamp and can continue to be used without re-stamping until such time as the stamp is not clearly legible.
- 23 Wheelchair – Position on Mat
At the point of delivery of the jack or bowl wheelchair bowlers must have the wheel nearest the bowling arm on the mat. Failure to observe this law constitutes foot-faulting.
- 66(i) Wheelchairs used in any IPC sanctioned competition or event must not cause any undue damage to the playing surface and must be approved by IPC Bowls. Wheels on wheelchairs must have a minimum width of 40mm (1 5/8 inches).
- 66(iii) At the point of delivery of the jack or bowl the wheelchair bowlers must have the wheel nearest the bowling arm on the mat. Failure to observe this law constitutes foot-faulting.

Additions

1. Eligibility
Any bowler from an IPC Member Nation or World Bowls Ltd. Member country who has been classified in accordance with the IPC Bowls Classification System shall be eligible to compete in any IPC sanctioned competition or event for the class in which they qualify or a class above that but can only compete in one class in any competition.
2. Combining of Classes
If there are not enough competitors for any class two or more classes may be combined to constitute an event.
3. B1, B2, and B3 Classes
Events for vision impaired bowlers will be subject to the conditions of play as published by the International Blind Bowls Board (IBBA).
4. B4 Class
Jack shall be maximum diameter 38mm diameter; bowls shall be maximum 64mm diameter. Minimum length of end shall be 5.0 metres, maximum length 10.0 metres. Bowlers play from fixed position for duration of game.
5. B5 Class
Maximum size of bowls shall be size "0" (117mm). Minimum length of end shall be 17 metres, maximum length 25 metres.

6. Wheelchair Bowlers
To avoid damage to greens or playing surfaces wheelchair bowlers must bowl from protective coverings if requested to do so by the host club at which any IPC sanctioned competition or event is conducted.

7. Conditions of Play
Conditions of Play for IPC sanctioned competitions will be published and distributed with the First Entry details of any competition but may be altered or amended by the organising committee if such alteration or amendment is necessary to the successful carrying out or completion of the competition.
